Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry Year 1 Curriculum – Sydney Australia

Course Outline

1. Purpose

GGCSSM Full Time is a one year course designed to bring students come into a more real, intimate and passionate relationship with Jesus, giving them His perspective and clearer direction for their lives. The course brings students revelation and transformation enabling them to walk in miracles, signs and wonders as Jesus and His disciples did, bringing revival into their own spheres of influence. Implementing the Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry (BSSM) Curriculum, Redding, California USA, this course is very practical, it prepares and launches students into their God given destinies with great acceleration!



Come and join the Army of Lovers God is raising up in Australia for such a time as this, revival from the Great South Land of the Holy Spirit to the World!

2. Outcomes

This course will give students:

- A more tangible, intimate relationship with Father, Son and Holy Spirit
- A practical understanding of the Bible from a Heavenly perspective
- An awakening and strengthening of their spiritual senses
- A deeper revelation of God's love which in turn will develop their character
- A better understanding of their identity in Christ
- Knowledge and confidence to operate in the gifts of the Spirit
- A greater understanding and trust in the Anointing
- Knowledge and skills in Kingdom culture, honour and revival
- A foundation to think and act biblically and make decisions based on love
- Communication, pastoral care and leadership skills
- Increased faith, hunger, peace, freedom and balance

3. Overview

GGCSSM is a boot camp style ministry training centre focused on and led by the presence of God. Students are changed forever by experiences and encounters with their Heavenly Father, bringing fruit that lasts to their own lives and the people around them.

The course emphasises hands-on training and field experience along with theological understanding. This creates a practical culture where all of the students are expected to take risks to stretch their faith and grow in their understanding of God in an authentic and encouraging learning environment, a community where students are free to step out without the fear of failure. GGCSSM believes that each verse of the Bible is an invitation into an experience with the Lord, therefore students are challenged to live the word of God.

Students learn how to walk in power and authority, from an offensive not defensive stance, from a place of rest and trust in Him, they learn how to discern, avoid and quickly overcome spiritual attacks and life issues for long term success. We find that in one year there is an accelerated Christian maturing that takes place which sometimes can take ten or twenty years of walking as a Christian to attain.

4. Synopsis

Students obtain real life experience by undertaking various field activities such as local and international mission's trips (non-compulsory), various community outreaches, Activation Days, involvement in a ministry or community service organisation and ministry placement in their local Church. This practical experience is gained in an area that complements the assessment project and the immediate goals of the student.

Combined with prayer, intercession, worship, small group discipleship and mentorship students are trained to continue in the ministry style of Jesus - to live in the presence of God, say what He is saying and do what He is doing.

GGCSSM understands the importance of fivefold ministry (Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors and Teachers) in the Church and so has incorporated these within the BSSM Year 1 Video Curriculum, GGCSSM Teachers and an array of powerfully anointed Australian and international guest speakers invited to speak at the school, bringing revelation and

impartation. GGCSSM equips students with how to minister in an Australian culture to bring revival more effectively to this nation and beyond.

As a ministry of GGC Life Church, partnering with New Covenant Ministries International (NCMI), GGCSSM has a heart to bring unity to the body of Christ. Students from all denominations and movements come together, as barriers are torn down strong empowering relationships are established with space for continued growth after graduation with the GGCSSM Alumni Community.



5. Curriculum Topics

Identity in Christ

Students will study the biblical truth of their identity in Christ in order to develop a belief system and lifestyle that reflect kingdom principles. Through the curriculum, they will learn they are simultaneously servants, children, and trusted friends of the Lord who are called to partner with Him in natural and supernatural ways to bring kingdom transformation here on the earth. They will hear messages about their adoption as royalty into God's family and their purpose to help others be reconciled to God and live according to their true identity.

Kingdom Culture of Honour & Revival

Students will learn about the kingdom culture that sustains revival. They will learn how to foster a culture of honour and revival, which invites the fruit of the supernatural into an environment. Students will learn how to develop an

awareness of the plans of heaven and steward the testimony of Jesus to see kingdom transformation in the lives of people. The curriculum offers messages on the importance of having the mind of Christ, the power of declarations, receiving revelation knowledge from God, partnering with the spiritual realm, and more.

Bible

Students will be empowered with understanding and tools to encounter God in the Word. Through the curriculum, students will learn that it is through relationship and empowerment by the Holy Spirit that we accurately experience and apply biblical truths. Students will survey the Old and New Testaments and learn who God is, who they are, and how He calls them to live. They will also hear foundational teachings of the Bible such as—the deity and humanity of Christ, salvation, sanctification, the person of the Holy Spirit, the fruit of the Holy Spirit, the baptism and gifts of the Holy Spirit, supernatural healing, sovereignty and freedom, evangelism and discipleship, and the return of the Lord.

Essential Truths of Christianity

Students will learn about the victorious redemptive work of Christ on the cross that provides freedom from the power of the enemy—sin, lies, sickness, and torment. They will hear powerful messages about how to live from the victory of the cross to see restoration in individuals, communities, and nations of the world. They will learn that God eradicated believers' sinful nature, and they are free and clothed in His righteousness. Students will be taught how to incorporate these and other kingdom values into their own lives. The curriculum messages include teaching about the goodness and love of God, forgiveness, the power of declarations, healing, prosperity of the mind, body, soul, and more.

The History of Revival

Students will study revivals' beginnings and the legacies of powerful revivalists who ignited fires of revival throughout the world. They will learn how to honour the spiritual inheritance of these men and women by building upon their breakthroughs. Students will have an opportunity to learn how to celebrate the advancements of past and current revivalists in a way that releases breakthrough in their own lives. The curriculum also includes messages about the roadblocks to revival, spiritual inheritance, and impartation.

The Gifts of the Spirit

Students will obtain a biblical foundation to understand the gifts of the Spirit that reveal the goodness of God to bring restoration to humanity. They will learn about how the gifts bring heaven's answers to earthly problems. Students will also have an opportunity to learn how partner with the Holy Spirit to minister in the gifts to see Christ's victory manifested in every circumstance. Messages include teaching and activation of words of knowledge, the prophetic, and healing.

Supernatural Lifestyle

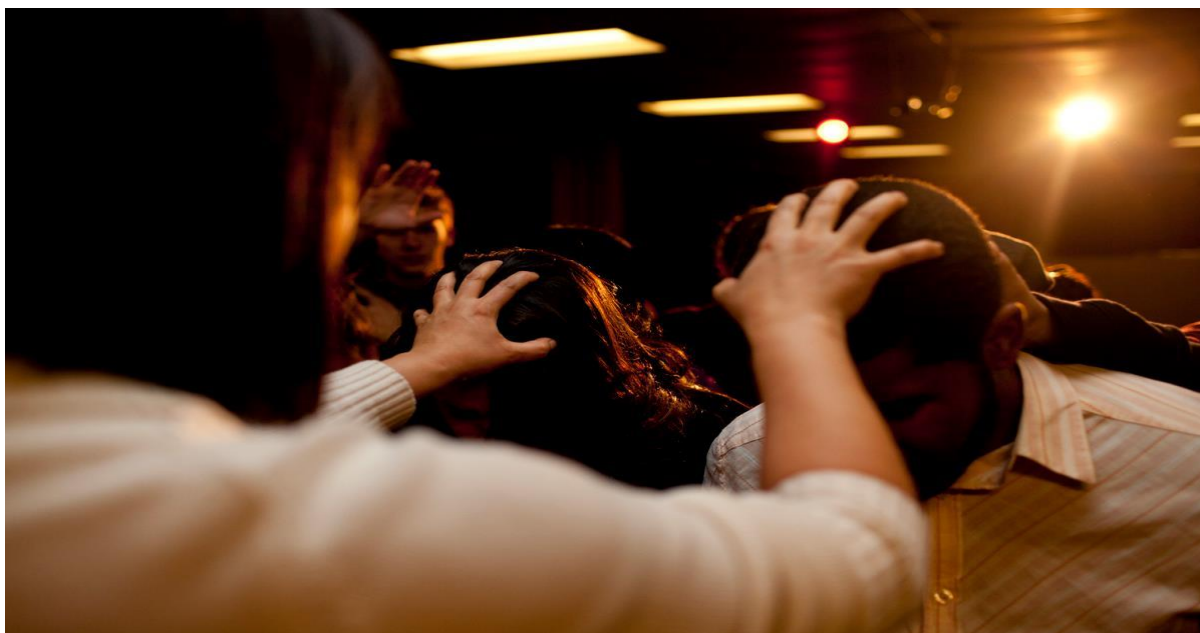
Students will learn how to naturally live a Spirit-led life following the voice, leading, and guiding of God's presence to release heaven on the earth. With Jesus as the model for life and ministry, students will learn how to demonstrate the supernatural through signs, wonders, and miracles in order to bring people into encounters with God. Through these teachings, students will grow in understanding how to operate in love when they take risks to release heaven into people's lives. Students will also be equipped with tools of evangelism to bring salvation to the lost.

Relationships

Students will learn about how to cultivate healthy relationships with men and women based on kingdom principles. They will learn that as they have been adopted into God's family, they are called to use love and wisdom to build healthy family and communities wherever they go. Through the curriculum, they will have the opportunity to understand how God has empowered believers to live a life of Christ-like purity and holiness. The curriculum also includes messages about dating, marriage, and communication in relationships.

Inner Healing & Deliverance Ministry

Students will learn about inner healing and deliverance ministry that targets the root of the things that hinder personal connection with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Through the curriculum, they will learn how to apply inner healing and deliverance tools in their own lives in order to become whole to pursue their destiny. They will also hear messages about how to help others step into freedom and intimacy with God.



6. Training Process

GGCSSM practices a wide variety of training methods. Actual delivery modes and training and assessment materials are adapted as needed in order to meet the needs of a diverse range of students. This will be done on a subject by subject basis in consultation with the trainer.

GGCSSM adopts adult-learning principles, and all students are treated as adult learners. Participants in this program are therefore expected to take charge of their own learning process. It is expected that each selected participant will be committed to meeting the requirements of the course and will attend relevant classes and activities including co-curricular activities, and complete all work required for assessment.

7. Assessment overview

Students who successfully complete the following requirements will be recommended for graduation:

- 90% attendance and participation
- Satisfactory completion of all relevant academic and practical requirements
- Payment of all outstanding fees owing to GGCSSM
- Maintained a satisfactory level of conduct during their time at the school
- Completion of co-curricular requirements including student/community participation

8. Entry Requirements

For entry into this course it is expected that the student is a committed Christian and actively involved in a local Church or Christian community.

General requirements for entry are:

- A completed student application form, see page 13
- Payment of the application fee, see page 13
- Attach your life journey testimony (500 words outlining your journey with God)
- Two references (i) from Church Pastor or leader (if not already provided) and (ii) from another Christian leader unrelated to yourself
- A successful interview with the Director or representative (where physically possible)
- Satisfactory English language skills
- Students should have basic computing skills



9. Duration

The GGCSSM Full Time Course is completed over a period of one year.

10. Location of Training

This course is delivered in Five Dock - Sydney, NSW, Australia.

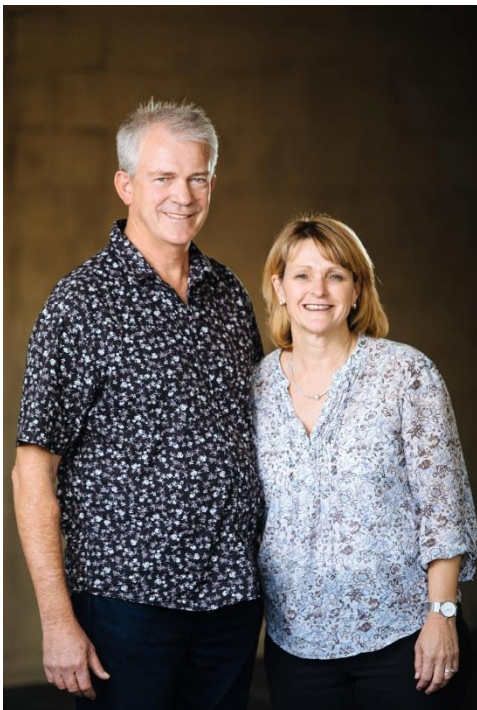
Note: Students who are not up to date with course fees will not be able to attend class unless Administration is made aware of circumstances and agreement has been made between the college and student for payment arrangement.
